UCLA Mo Ostin Basketball Center Indoor Wall Padding

The Mo Ostin state-of-the-art basketball practice facility for UCLA athletics celebrated its grand opening. The facility is named after legendary music industry executive and philanthropist Morris "Mo" Ostin, who graduated from UCLA and generously donated \$10 million to the project. With approximately 35,000 gross square feet of space, it features two separate courts — Russell Westbrook Court for the men's team and Ann Meyers Drysdale Court for the women's team. Special features include glarefree indirect light, natural ventilation intakes that circulate fresh air through the courts, an expansive video board, and an impressive sound system.

SPORTS VENUE PADDING worked closely with PCL Construction and installed a total of 165 Bruin blue wall pads, ranging from 6'6" to 7'7" in height, around the perimeter of the two basketball courts. Special attention to detail is displayed from corner to corner with over 50 custom cut-outs in all, allowing access to storage, electrical panels and outlets, emergency equipment, and air vents.
